The students will stay with families in Revenga, a small village near Segovia.

The students will have a break in which refreshments will be provided. They will go to the swimming pool with other young people until lunch time.

After lunch, (siesta time lasts until 17.00pm) the students will have some free, quiet time in which they could do some homework, read a book, watch a DVD. After 17.00 we will visit nearby places of interest.

After tea, students will have free time to stroll in the village, go to the cinema (listings permitting).

On Tuesday we will walk at to Cabeza Grande, a nearby hill overlooking the village, with superb views across the plain.

The price will be £675 for the 9 days, to include full board, tuition, transport and entrance fees. Students are responsible for their own air fare. I will meet and take students from and to Madrid.

Other important information:

Check your passport: it needs to be valid for 6 months from date of travel.

You will need to check insurance and health card.

Pack small: the trip is only for 9 days.

Mobile phones are OK to take on the trip, however, they will be switched off in the mornings while working, and while visiting museums. There is limited internet connection in the houses but free wi-fi is provided by and near the town hall.

You will need to take stationary, pens, pencils, rubber, notebook, etc.
